St George's Hospital has started work on the bespoke 'chill out' room for young people being treated for cancer. It will give them a chance to meet other young people going through similar experiences. They will be able to get away from the ward or use it when visiting outpatients clinics.

The room will have comfortable chairs to relax in and a TV with access to games consoles, books and DVDs. There will be WiFi and the newly-appointed TYA (teenage & young adults) nurse will be able to provide a laptop/iPads for the patients to use if they don't have their own, as well as therapeutic activities.

The room is currently being designed by specialists Grosvenor Interiors (funded by Teenage Cancer Trust). **They are asking for ideas from us for wall images to sum up the area and recognise the support our Furzedown community has made in making all this possible!**
